Installing

Windows

- 1. Double-click setup.exe, which can be found in the folder where you expanded the downloaded file.**

The Setup dialog will be displayed.

NOTE

- A user account with administrative privileges must be used for installation.
- If the User Account Control window is displayed, click either Yes or Continue.

- 2. Follow the instructions displayed to install Audio Phraser.**

Mac

- 1. Double-click AudioPhraser.pkg, which can be found in the folder where you expanded the downloaded file.**

The Setup dialog will be displayed.

Uninstalling

Windows

- **Windows 7, Windows 8.1 and Windows 10**

Click Control Panel > Programs or Uninstall a program. Select the program you wish to uninstall, and then click Uninstall/Change. Follow the instructions from the displayed dialog to uninstall the application. If the User Account Control window is displayed, click either Yes or Continue.

Mac

Delete Audio Phraser from the Yamaha folder in Applications.

Double-click the Audio Phraser icon to launch the application.

Double-click Audio Phraser from the Yamaha folder in Applications.
